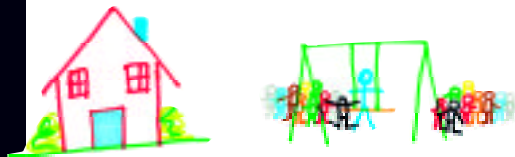
Hello! My name is Adam. I want to tell you about something

need it.

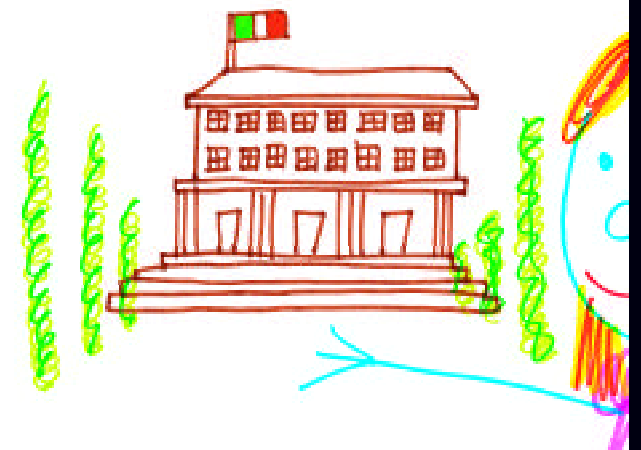


Most important of all, the Convention says we
